General Notes

1. Please do not request to take the final exam during the regular class period. It is expected that regular class work will continue through the last class of the term, **Monday, December 12, 2022**.
2. The exam is held in the same room in which the class regularly meets unless the instructor informs you otherwise.
3. Conflicts should be resolved with the instructor involved; if this is impossible, please consult the department chair.
4. Students must obtain the prior approval of their instructors to change an exam date or time.
5. Exam periods are usually for three hours; however, the time limit for an exam may be less than three hours (in a few special cases, an exam may require more than three hours).
6. Students who are guilty of dishonesty in an exam may incur the penalty of failure in the course or for the exam.
7. Refer to the Honor Code for procedure for reporting violations of the Honor Code.
8. The exam schedule for schools participating in the Baltimore Student Exchange Program differs from Loyola's.
9. In the event of a University delayed opening or closing due to inclement weather, all exams will remain as scheduled. Final exams will occur online.
